



IDFC BOND FUND - Income Plan

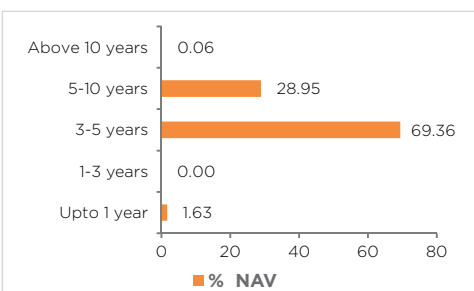

For very short term parking of surplus or emergency corpus

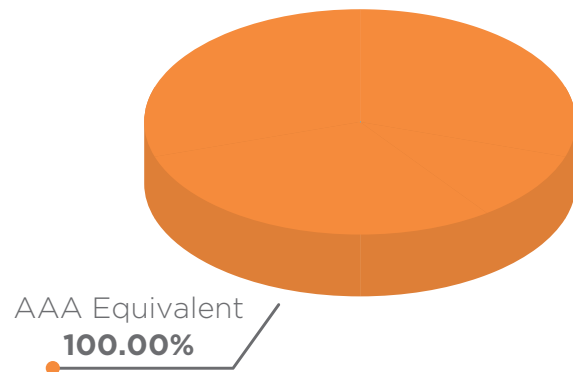
CORE


